e are eager to welcome new students to the school in Year 12. In a typical year, new students make up around one third of our cohort and we very much appreciate the vibrancy and perspective that is added by these external candidates.

Weekly boarding in the Sixth Form provides our students with the perfect opportunity to gain independence, self-motivation and academic discipline; skills which they can build upon and then utilise to ensure a seamless transition into university life.

Boarders are consistently the best young leaders and team players in the school. They are amongst those who participate most in sports, music and enrichment activities, and achieve the most outstanding academic results.

WHAT CAN YOU EXPECT?

- · Excellent academic standards
 - In August 2019, 88.6% of all A Level entries were awarded A*- B grades, with over 25% of candidates achieving at least 3 A* grades. In addition, 71% of candidates gained at least AAB.
 - Furthermore, 47.7% of GCSE entries were awarded the highly coveted grade 9 and 76% were awarded grades 9-8. 90.9% of entries were awarded grades 9-7 and 100% of pupils gained five grades 9-4 including English and Maths. In addition, 97.6% gained five grades 9-7, 58.9% gained ten grades 9-7 and over 94% of candidates achieved the English Baccalaureate.
- · Excellent standards of pastoral care
 - Student welfare is of paramount importance to us and we strive to ensure that all students leave Reading School as happy, content and well-rounded young men, fully prepared for their next steps into the world.
- · Your own room with study area in our COVID secure boarding houses
- · Dedicated Sixth Form communal areas including kitchen
- · Tailored support from a team of boarding tutors who are all academic staff at the school
- · The opportunity to develop leadership skills, support community projects and contribute to boarding life
- · Access to our COVID secure fitness suite
- WiFi access and Netflix subscription
- The chance to develop lifelong friendships and an ideal stepping stone to university life away from home

Principles for Covid-Secure Boarding
