



Year 12 End of Year Exams 2026

Purpose

- The Year 12 End of Year Exams will take place the week commencing 18th May.
- These exams represent an opportunity to showcase the consistent and persistent hard work that you have demonstrated this year.
- Although the End of Year Exams will contribute significantly towards your UCAS prediction, performance throughout the year will be considered and holistic view of the student taken.
- Different departments have slightly different approaches to the prediction process. Mr Whitehorn will share a document with all students relating to predictions, as well as resits.
- No student should consider the resit process as a primary mechanism for achieving their desired prediction. These summer exams should be the single focus to demonstrate their best work.



Expectations

- Students should be in the correct school uniform. Shirt and tie only with trousers and school shoes is permitted, but if students do wear an outer layer, it must be a suit jacket.
- Students must bring all equipment required. There will not be spare equipment available.
- Food and drink is not permitted in the exam rooms.
- Students should follow best exam practice, specifically silence in the exam hall and when queuing to enter exams. **No mobile phones permitted in the exam room.**

Attendance

- Session 1 commences at 8:20.
- Session 2 commences at 11:00.
- Session 3 commences at 13:20.
- Students should only be on the school site for their allocated exam slots.
- Students wishing to be onsite before, after or between exams must email Mr McGall to request this.
- Students do not have to sign in and out at student services.
- Registration will take place in the exam rooms.

Exam Clashes

- Students with exam clashes must email Mrs Clarke by Friday 8th of May.
- The email should include:
 - The subject and timing of the clash.
 - The earliest possible exam slot in which the clashed exam can be sat.



Locations of Exams

- The exams will take place in Big School, Music School and Rooms 5 to 7.
- Exam registers with locations will be published to students by Friday 15th May.
- Registration points:
 - Students with exams in Music School should meet to be registered outside Music School.
 - Students with exams In Big School should meet to be registered on the Front Terrace.
 - Students with exams in Rooms 5 to 7 should meet to be registered in the Refectory.
- Students must be lined up **alphabetical order by subject class** in preparation for registration.
