How does Berkshire TSA deliver teacher training?

The Berkshire Teaching School Alliance participates in the School Direct Programme of school-led training. We work with The University of Reading to deliver training, offering both salaried and unsalaried routes.

You will have one lead school, and will spend time in a second school and gain a substantial amount of school-based experience.

The school direct route leads to Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) with the option of studying for a PGCE.
