He has previously spent 11 years in the Civil Service joining the Fast Stream graduate scheme after undertaking a Philosophy, Politics and Economics degree at Keble College, Oxford. Over that period, Raghuv taken a number of roles including working on a White Paper to establish a new legal basis for Social Care, negotiating with HM Treasury as part of the Spending Review to decide the funding settlement for Health and most recently working for Jeremy Hunt, Secretary of State for Health, as his Principal Private Secretary.

In the past, he has also taken a career break to undertake a Masters in Political Philosophy whilst living in Barcelona.
