Jon's novel "Nowhere" has been shortlisted for the Bolton and Calderdale children's book awards, winning the Calderdale Children's Fiction Award 2014, Hampshire Independent Schools book award and Reading Libraries Battle of the Books award. In 2014 he was nominated for the Carnegie Medal. Jon has also won the Calderdale Discover Learning children's fiction award 2014.

Jon will be signing books at the end of each talk. Books are available by pre-ordering and paying in advance. Details of the titles that can be pre-ordered and how much they cost are given below.
