**2. Arrangements for wet weather:**

**If weather makes the event unsafe, a cancellation decision will be made by 08:50, in which instance the day will revert to the normal timetable.**

**3. Route to Palmer Park:**

Pupils in years 7–10 will be taken to Palmer Park via school drive, along the A4 to Cemetery Junction and cross Wokingham Road either at Cemetery Junction or at the lights nearer Palmer Park. No Y7-10 pupil is to cross the road unless under supervision of the accompanying teachers.

**4. Health and Safety and behaviour**

A gentle reminder, that you are all representing Reading School and therefore should conduct yourselves in an appropriate manner, in line with the values of Reading School, to and from the venue and whilst at the Stadium. You are responsible for clearing away your own rubbish and making sure that we do not leave the stadium a mess.
