

Boarding induction at a glance

<p>Fire Safety/evacuation If the fire alarm goes off, leave the building via the nearest exit point. Line up in your year group 2 meters apart from other year groups in the usual place.</p>	<p>Kitchen Use hand sanitiser before accessing the kitchen. Max 2 people from the same year group. Clean anything used and clear surfaces. See posters for guidance.</p>	<p>Food/snacks No changes, social distancing and number restriction when accessing the kitchen.</p>	<p>People to trust The boarding team has increased and changed a lot this year. In addition, Housemasters, Deputies and Matrons will be available for you. Only one boy at time will be invited into the offices and boarding staff will be visible in the house.</p>
<p>Groups Year 7, 8 and 9 will be a group with a shared common room. Only these year groups are permitted in the dorms corridor. Year 10 and 11 will be a group with a shared common room. Only these year groups can access the top floor corridor. Year 12 and 13 will be a group in the first floor. Senior common room as communal space.</p>	<p>Activities Boarding clubs will still be on and outdoor activities will be delivered when possible. Cricket, Football, Ultimate frisbee, Outdoor Gym (new), Pétanque, etc are some examples of activities that we are planning to deliver but we want to hear from you</p>	<p>Rules to going off-site Risk assessments do not allow boarders to go off site during the week including clubs. Take-aways will be possible with the contactless system provided by delivery companies.</p>	<p>IT Wi-Fi provision has been improved and all boarders will be allowed multiple devices on our network. Registration must be completed and details will be shared on your induction. Bring your own device (BYOD) policy will be updated – with student council reps – and boys from Year 8 onwards will be able to bring their own laptop</p>
<p>Prep Year 7 will continue working in the prep room Year 8 and 9 will be working in classrooms supervised by a boarding prefect and regular checked by a member of staff.</p>	<p>School day – routines This will be explained by your form tutor on the first day back</p>	<p>Laundry Now clean and dirty laundry are not located in the same room. Full details on the first day back.</p>	<p>Reach We are no longer using boardingware to monitor boarders. Reach will be the new system in place from September. Parents, staff and boarders will have access to it via phone app and the house iPad.</p>
<p>Boarding security protocol Apply hand sanitiser before using your finger print in doors.</p>		<p>Communal spaces There might be moments where you need to access or go through one of the out of bounds areas to access parts of the house (E.g, to go to Karen’s office). Use hand sanitiser before/after and do not touch any surface enroute.</p>	
<p>Bedrooms Boarders will not be allowed to enter other rooms. Allocated social spaces and outdoor space will be the area to meet with friends.</p>	<p>Room expectations Cleaning will be enhanced in boarding and we will need to work together to make it as easy as possible. Rooms need to be perfectly tidy before cleaners go in so the cleaning can be more effective and efficient.</p>	<p>Boarding routines See the following pages for different timings for different groups</p>	<p>Relationships Although we are using a group system and social distancing in boarding, we encourage boys to share time together across different year groups. This can be done outdoors observing social distancing.</p>
