

Dear Parents and Carers,

In these unusual circumstances we are writing to introduce the Reading School Parents Association (RSPA) to you. We would like to take this opportunity to warmly welcome you and your son to the Reading School family and we hope that you and your families are well.

The RSPA is an active and vibrant part of the Reading School Family and we are looking forward to welcoming and assisting you through every step even before your son officially joins the School in September. Unfortunately, the Corona Virus social restriction means that we cannot currently organise any in person introduction events. However, as soon as it is possible after ease of social meeting restriction, the RSPA will organise a social event, so that all new parents and boys have the opportunity to connect and build up the ever so necessary bond that will last till the boys leave the school.

The RSPA feel that one of their most vital roles in the life of the School is supporting the families of the boys and in particular the families of the new Year 7 boys. As a member of the RSPA we are delighted to say you are joining a network of parents across the whole School who can be called on to support your son's Reading School journey. Classlist – RSPA Online Membership Portal

As an RSPA member you will have access to our parent communication portal (Classlist). Here you will be able to immediately start to communicate with other members in your class and you will also be supported by an existing parent member who is there to help you, answer questions you may have and to provide ongoing help and information updates in getting you ready for September. We will also use this route to keep you updated as soon as we can plan introduction and social events and openings for the RSPA 2nd Hand Uniform Shop etc.

Classlist is where we as parents support each other from a very active Lost Property group, to parents creating their own groups for school trips or car sharing or even making groups for boys who are travelling in the same bus or train. Here RSPA members are able to ask questions, receive notifications around important events and share information within communities e.g. boarding communities, year groups etc.

The RSPA objectives are to support the School, parents, carers and students, enabling opportunities or resources to be available to our boys that might not have been available otherwise. We do this using the membership fees and via our many routes of fundraising

At RSPA, we carry out the following activities:

- 1. Providing a support network for the parents and carers during their time at the school.
- 2. Supporting extra-curricular activities e.g. External competitions, Junior Prize Giving & Year 13 Leavers' celebration.
- 3. Helping enhance the school's environment e.g. funding a Multi-Use Games Area, funding the outdoor gym equipment over the Covid pandemic time and a Canopy Project to provide a covered area outside the Library. We are also currently installing new benches around the school.
- 4. Fundraising to help fill any requirements not by met by the Government budget, such as two new minibuses & resources for extracurricular activities.
- 5. Providing non-standard, additional and enhanced classroom resources e.g. books, biology & chemistry laboratory equipment, Art Resources, research laptops and leadership resources.
