

Internal Exams 21st – 25th June

What do I need to bring?

- All your usual equipment essentials for exams eg. pens (and spares), pencils, rulers, rubbers, calculators
- Water bottle
- Revision material - exercise books, revision books, textbooks, paper, flashcards etc.
- Make sure you have transferred any digital (lockdown) notes into paper form (summarised/printed) in advance.
- A print out of your exam timetable (or write it on a sheet of paper to have to hand)

How each day will work:

- Registration at 8.25 for lower school with tutors in your usual tutor rooms.
- First exam begins 8.50 in allocated rooms (see schedule)
- Students will sit in alphabetical order (line up outside your room ready).
- Y7 & 8 will revise in their exam room when they do not have an exam.
- Y9 will revise in the Refectory when they do not have an exam.
- Y10 can leave after session 2. If you have no exam for session 1, you must go to the LRC or L7
- After an exam finishes, you will remain in the exam room until the end of the session so should always have extra revision with you. You will be given revision advice and guidance.
