

Dear Year 13s,

As we make plans for A level and GCSE results days in August we are aware that, at the moment, flexible plans are still needed as we monitor government guidelines on the easing of restrictions. We are planning for students to collect their results on site and be able to share the moment with their fellow classmates. The plan we communicate to you today is based on the current anticipation of a further easing of restrictions by 19th July. If the guidance changes between now and then we will adjust our plans and communicate to you accordingly.

A Level results day – Tuesday 10th August – 8.30-9.30am

Arriving at school

- Only students will be allowed on site, no parents or carers. Students must arrive by foot.
- Year 13s should check UCAS before coming into school to collect their results. UCAS should display if you have been accepted by your first choice University. The window for collecting results is 8.30-9.30am, so if you have been accepted by your University we encourage you not to arrive at school at 8.30am, but to try and arrive later in the hour window.
- If you have advised that you will be unable to attend results day in person, your results will be emailed to you after all attending students have left the school site. Alternatively, you may give written permission to a nominee to act on your behalf. In order for the results to be released, the note of authorisation should be presented by the nominee.

Collecting of results

- If the weather is dry the results will be laid out on tables outside reception. The tables will be split into three groups:
 - Group A (surnames A - D)
 - Group B (surnames E - O)
 - Group C (surnames P - Z)
- If the weather is inclement, results will be laid out on tables in the refectory. The tables will be split into the same three groups
- If students have queries regarding their results or university options they should go to the LRC where Mr Lloyd and Mr Whitehorn will be available to offer advice and guidance.
