










WHAT CAN YOU EXPECT?

Current Boarding Fees for Academic Year 2021/2022

£12,660 per year

£4,220 per term

These fees cover every aspect of boarding life including:

- All evening activities
- Gym membership
- Boarding trips
- Meals and snacks

It does not cover:

- School uniform
- Curriculum school trips

We are a state funded academy so there are **no tuition fees.**
