

Year 8 Internal Exams - Mr Elmore

During belonging weeks, both internal and formal exams are taking place. It is vital that all students are respectful of this when moving around the site.

These exams are for practice and to give students a chance to demonstrate what they have learnt and understood this year. Students will have a chance to explore different revision techniques and the chance to develop different strategies so that when Y11/13 are reached students are more than capable of achieving their best. These exams will also ensure that every student experiences and understands the process of sitting many exams in one go.

The exams will highlight areas for improvement so that each student can work on these afterwards to progress their own learning. These exams will only be useful if students fully reflect on the process afterwards during exam feedback.

Breaks will be 10:35-11:05. Lunches will be 12:50-13:40. Given that breaks are later, students may wish to pack an extra snack and plenty of water.

No phones, headphones or laptops. (Unless specific requests have been confirmed)

All revision material should be physical and prepared according to each student's exam breaks as per their exam timetable.

Students should therefore adhere to all exam rules:

Silent work; Bring appropriate writing materials in a clear pencil case; Wrist watches on the table; The invigilator cannot help you interpret the question

Register in assigned rooms at the start of each session.

Activities sessions are subject to change but students should bring appropriate footwear ready for when the games sessions are scheduled.

Break & lunch should be in the refectory / LRC area / Chapel areas ONLY so as to minimise disturbance to external exams.

When the exam is shorter than the session time, the invigilator will decide what time the exam starts.

Students should bring in appropriate revision material each day for silent study when they do not have an exam.

Remember - the invigilator cannot help interpret questions. They should answer to the best of their ability.
