Year 11 / 12 Finland Trip Summer 2024:

Dear Parents/carer

We are excited to provide you with details of an exciting opportunity that we have been planning with our partners in Finland at the end of the summer term next year.

We have been working with Adventure Apes for a number of years and our students have had the most incredible adventures and learning experiences in Finland. Their approach to outdoor learning, adventure and leadership is very much aligned with our school's vision and this expedition is a chance for our students to collaborate and contribute to a team that will experience the challenge of a canoeing expedition in pristine wilderness on the edge of the Arctic Circle.

The program takes place from the 11^h of July 2024 for seven days, and full details of the week are included.

Using small shelters and wild camping, students will be taking a lead from the beginning, preparing and cooking all meals and demonstrating their ability to enable and sustain a climate of collaboration and culture of contribution.

It is important that students recognise the nature of this challenge and our open to working with any and all students and we have intentionally made this experience available to those in both Year 11 and 12, as this trip is an opportunity for students to demonstrate the leadership and character that the Sixth Form Character Education programme values.

All students that are keen to take part will complete a short leadership themed task in groups and receive feedback on their contributions. If there are still too many applicants for the places available, a randomised ballot will take place.

EXPEDITION OUTLINE:

- > 7 days, 6 nights
- Experience the best of the Arctic summer as you paddle across a beautiful freshwater lake in Finnish Lapland.
- Canoe by day and camp in remote camping sites by night.
- Complete some charity work for the hiking area and enjoy the artic summer nights in the wild.

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We recognise that this is an expensive trip, in part due to the nature of the environment that we are operating in and the cost of licenses and camping permits, but we also want our senior students to have access to the most exciting of opportunities.

The current estimated cost for this trip is £1650, this cannot be confirmed until our flights have been booked based on the levels of interest.

An initial expression of interest is due by the 3rd of July and a non-refundable deposit of £400 by the 9th September 2023 based on the offer of a place.

Students in receipt of the Pupil Premium will be able to meet the majority of the cost of this trip with school support.
