### Re: House Music Competition 2023

The House Music Competition is now in its 88th year and remains the most significant event in our annual calendar. This year, the competition is scheduled to take place on **Sunday 26**th **November from 15:00 to 19:30 at The Hexagon**, Queens Walk, RG1 7QF.

The competition will showcase the usual array of outstanding performances from our five houses. Ensemble acts will include both large and small ensembles performing music from films. Solo acts will feature the Senior soloists (students in Year 11-13) and Junior soloists (students in Year 7-10).

Ticket release will take place as follows:

#### Rehearsals

• On the event day at The Hexagon, a rehearsal will be held. Each house will have a timed 60-minute slot in order to get technical elements prepared - this is not a dress rehearsal.

- Please note that these are closed rehearsals, so parents/public are not allowed entry into the auditorium.
- Main entrance (next to the Box Office) will not be opened during the rehearsal. Please drop your son(s) at the stage door (ground floor) and depart.
- Students should sign-in with their house prefects at the stage door (ground floor).
- Any students who need to carry medication, such as inhalers or epi-pens must ensure they have it on them. They will not be able to take part without it and will be returned to parental care.
- Once each rehearsal slot has finished, students will need to sign out with their house prefects at the stage door (ground floor) and must leave the venue they cannot stay on site as they will not be supervised. Please pick up your son(s) from here.
- Boarding pupils please ensure you have made arrangements with family or friends if you are participating.
- Students will need to bring all their equipment with them to the rehearsal including instruments, music and any other bits and pieces (drumsticks and guitar leads for example). It may be possible to leave some larger items in dressing rooms afterwards, but smaller items should not be left.

### **Drop-off or Pick Up**

- The show will commence promptly at 15:30 and all students need to be at the Hexagon no later than 15:00 for final preparation. Parents and students must enter and exit through the main entrance (next to the Box Office) of The Hexagon only.
- If you are dropping pupils off at 14:45, you are welcome to remain in the public area to buy snacks, drinks, and raffle tickets. **Auditorium will be open the public from 15:00**.
- The backstage area is strictly off limits to anyone other than authorised staff and students.
- It is anticipated that the competition will finish between 19:00 and 19:30. It may take some time to release boys to parents and this will be done by house to keep things flowing.
